

Workman's cap

Cut four pieces lining and four of outside. $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance is included.

With wrong sides together, sew two lining pieces together along one side and along sloped top. Add another panel to this, and finally the fourth sewn to the first to create a dome/pyramid.

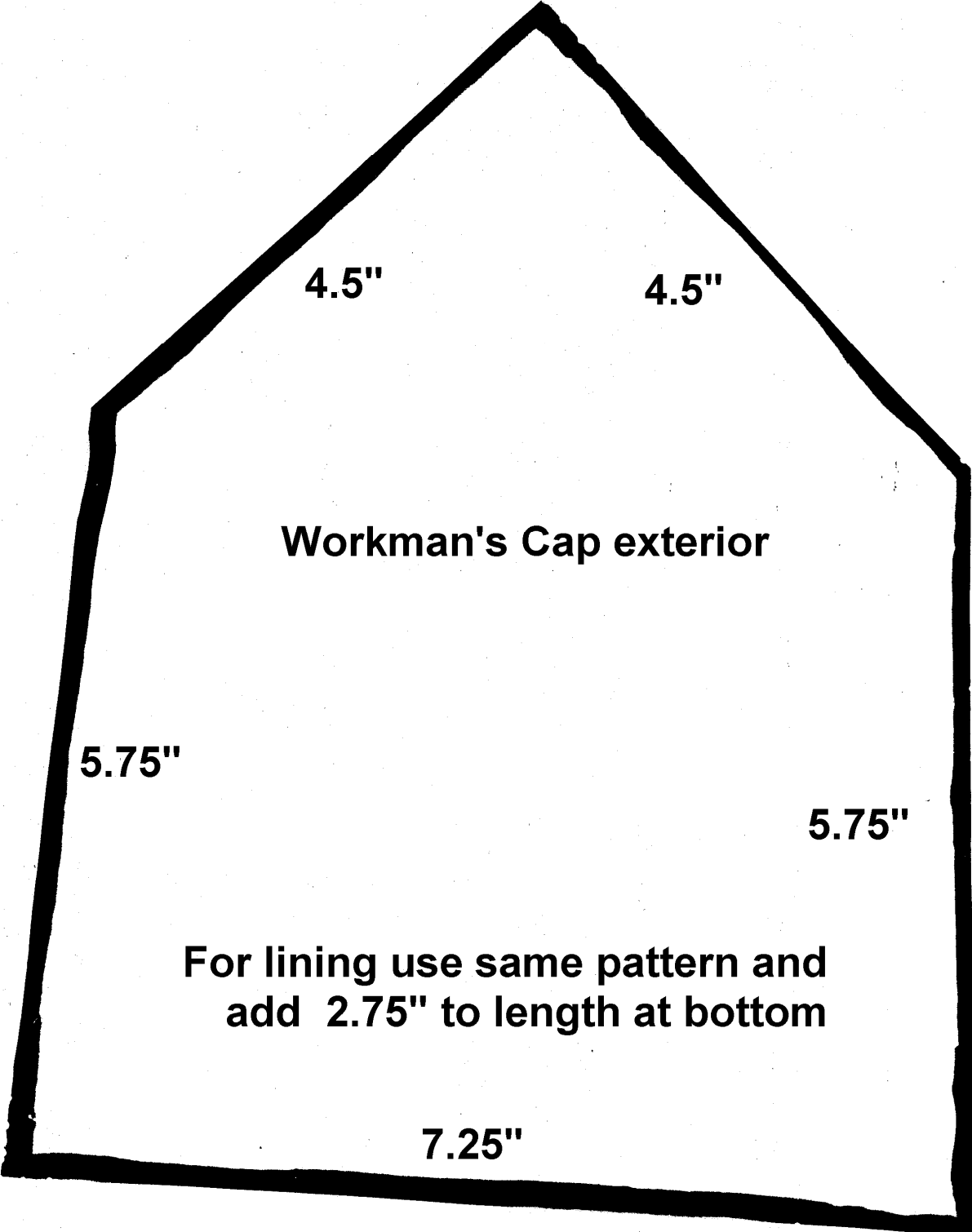
Repeat with four exterior pieces.

With wrong sides together sew lining and top around bottom edge - DO NOT sew all the way around. You will need to leave an opening to turn your creation right sides out. Sew this closed by hand.

Push the lining up into the outside. Note lining will be longer. Roll this longer portion up on the outside of the hat to create a cuff type roll.

Hats may be of most any color. Stripes and checks also are appropriate (avoid $\frac{3}{8}$ " gingham). Avoid prints and flowers. Lining and exterior may be of different colors to create a contrast when the edge is rolled.

Pattern may be enlarged or decreased to create different sizes.
